- Ensure that each university has elected OSLA Student Representatives (from Year 1&2) onto their Student Council.
- Connecting with OSLA student members on a regular basis through our online Student Interest Group.
- Take an active role in planning and coordination of student initiatives and event such as, the "Theory to Therapy Student Conference" held in May 2019.
- Maintain communication with university program advisors to provide updates on student

programs, research, and activities

- Collaborate with the College of Audiologists and Speech-Language Pathologists (CASLPO)'s and Speech-Language & Audiology of Canada (SAC) 's Student representatives on potential networking and professional development events.
- Provide assistance and feedback to OSLA's Coordinator of Professional Development regarding potential student conferences, workshops, job opportunities, and scholarships.

### Requirements:

OSLA has two student positions on the Board of Directors. Year 1 and Year 2 Student members must be enrolled in a certified Audiology or Speech-Language Pathology program in the province of Ontario.

We are now accepting applications for **ONE Speech-Language Pathology student** to sit on OSLA's Board of Directors. **Students must be in Year 1 of their program\***.

*\*Students applying must be Year 1 of their program to ensure a one-year overlap with our Year 2 Student board member.*
